The La Follette Policy Poll was conducted from July 14 to September 24, 2021. Researchers at the La Follette School worked with the <u>University of</u> <u>Wisconsin Survey Center (UWSC)</u> to ensure an authoritative, representative poll. Nearly 1,600 residents answered the eight-page survey, distributed by mail to 5,000 randomly selected Wisconsin households. The poll responses come from 71 of Wisconsin's 72 counties, with high response rates making the results representative of public opinion in the Badger State. The margin of error for the full sample is +/- 2.5% (at 95% confidence).
